What is the Exmouth Community Larder?

The Exmouth Larder is a store of non perishable food to help individuals and families experiencing a food crisis, who have no food and no money to buy food.

This is an initiative of Christians Together in Exmouth operated by volunteers from local churches.

We do not normally supply food on a direct request, but respond to advice from referring agencies who will have vouchers to give to people they recognise as being in emergency need.

Church leaders and other agencies are provided with vouchers that entitle the bearer to food sufficient for their household for up to 3 days.
